2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Mayor Lattanzi to approve the minutes of the January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meetings of City Council. **All in favor – 5-0**

**NEW BUSINESS:**



Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to authorize the purchase of one (1) 2017 Ford Interceptor Utility Model K8A-AWD Police Vehicle from Day Ford, Inc., through the SHACOG Joint Purchasing Alliance at a cost of \$41,705.00, with payment from the Capital Projects Fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
  
2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson to authorize the purchase of ten (10) new Axon Body cameras, with a five (5) year service and maintenance program at a total cost of \$29,897.49, with payment from the Capital Projects fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
  
3. Motion by Councilman Kurta, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve the DiMarco Construction Company Headquarters site plan for the property located at the intersection of Maple Avenue and State Route 837, designated as lot & block 763-P-215 as recommended by the Planning Commission. **All in favor – 5-0**
  
4. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve the request from the AARP Chapter # 1612 to use the lodge and pavilion for their annual picnic on Wednesday, July 26<sup>th</sup> at no charge. **All in favor 5-0**
  
5. Motion by Mayor Lattanzi, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve the purchase of one (1) new 2015 Caterpillar Backhoe from Cleveland Brothers as per their proposal submitted under State Piggy-back contract number 440011420 at a total cost of \$ 78,875.00, with payment from the Capital Projects fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
  
6. Motion by Councilman Kurta, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to authorize the donation of \$2,500 towards the City of Clairton Recreation / American Legion Summer concert to be held on Sunday, June 18<sup>th</sup>. **All in favor – 5-0**
  
7. Motion by Mayor Lattanzi, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson to authorize the bidding of the Lincoln Way Demolition and Clean-Up project under the Community Infrastructure and Tourism Fund (CITF) Grant. **All in favor -5-0**


8. Motion by Councilwoman Johnson, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve and ratify expenditures for General Fund Warrant Nos. 01042017, 01102017, 01202017, 01252017 and 01302017. **All in favor -5-0 – (Councilman Kurta abstained from voting on any Comcast expenditures.)**
  
9. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Mayor Lattanzi to appoint Joseph Lazur as the Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of Clairton. **All in favor – 5-0**  
(Joseph Lazur was sworn in by Mayor Lattanzi as Emergency Management Coordinator)
