2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson to approve the minutes of the January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 meetings of Clairton City Council. **All in favor – 5-0**

1. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Lattanzi to approve and adopt Ordinance No. 1919, an Ordinance authorizing the placement of stop signs at the intersection of Lafayette Drive and Woolridge Avenue. **All in favor – 5-0**
2. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve and adopt Resolution No. 1684, a Resolution authorizing the destruction and disposal of various Police Department records in compliance with the Retention and Disposition Schedule for Records of Pennsylvania Municipal Governments. **All in favor – 5-0**
3. Motion by Councilman Lattanzi, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve and adopt Resolution No. 1685 authorizing the filing of an application with the Allegheny County Redevelopment Authority for a Community Infrastructure and Tourism Fund (CITF) grant in the amount of \$250,000 for the Lincoln Way Project. **All in favor – 5-0**
4. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Mayor Lattanzi to approve and adopt Resolution No. 1686 authorizing the filing of an application with the Allegheny County Redevelopment Authority for a Community Infrastructure and Tourism Fund (CITF) grant in the amount of \$35,000 in support of Pennsylvania House Bill 1080, the Low Income Water and Wastewater Assistance Program. **All in favor – 5-0**

5. Motion by Councilman Lattanzi, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve the purchase one (1) Ford Interceptor Police vehicle now and one in the fall with payment from the Capital Projects Fund.

6. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Mayor Lattanzi to approve the purchase of three (3) trunk vaults for Police vehicles at a total cost of \$ 7,950.00, with payment from the Capital Projects fund.

Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilman Lattanzi to approve the request of the Clairton Chapter #1612 of the A.A.R.P. to use the lodge, pavilion #1 and shelter # 9 free of the rental charge for their annual picnic to be held on Wednesday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016. **All in favor – 5-0**
8. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson re-appointing Robert Haramia to a four (4) year term on the Planning Commission, term to run through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019. **All in favor – 5-0**
9. Motion by Councilwoman Johnson, seconded by Councilman Ford appointing Nicole Sikorski-Jacobs to a three (3) year term on the Zoning Hearing Board, term to run through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018.  
**All in favor – 5-0**
10. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilman Lattanzi re-appointing Howard J. Bednar as the City representative to the Steel Valley Authority Board for a two (2) year term, term to run through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017. **All in favor – 5-0**
11. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson approving the exoneration of City of Clairton delinquent real estate taxes for the years 2010 and back for the property located at 310 Waddell Avenue, lot & block 878-E-315 as per the agreement between the City of Clairton and Wilbur and Wandra Sparks dated May10th, 2010.

12. Motion by Councilman Lattanzi, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve and ratify expenditures for General Fund Warrants No. 01082016 and 01222016. **All in favor – 5-0**


