NEW BUSINESS:



2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Lattanzi accepting the proposal from Alpha Communication for the installation of cameras in the Police Department at a cost of \$7,030.00, with payment from the Capital Project Fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
3. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich approving a donation of \$200.00 to the Clairton Little League Baseball Association. **All in favor – 5-0**
4. Motion by Councilwoman Johnson, seconded by Councilman Ford to purchase two (2) 2016 Dodge Ram 5500, 4WD dump trucks with complete snow plowing and salt spreading capabilities from A & H Equipment Company at a total cost of \$171,910.60, with payment from the Capital Project Fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
