Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to adjourn the meeting. **All in favor – 5-0**

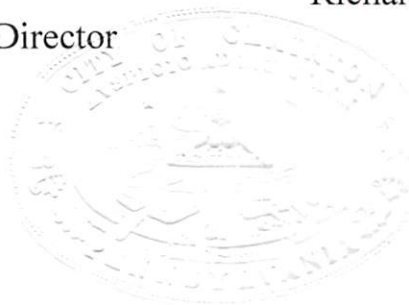
