Motion Councilman Lattanzi, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to adjourn meeting. **All in favor – 5-0**

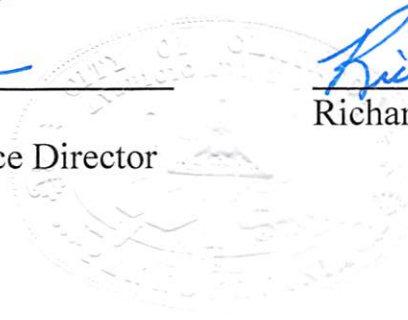
