Resolutions authorizing the filing of applications for Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) – Year 44 funds from the Allegheny County Department of Economic Development for road reconstruction projects. **All in favor – 5-0**

5. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve the distribution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Foreign Fire Insurance Premium Tax allocation of \$25,647.17 to the Clairton Volunteer Fire Department Relief Association for use as per State law. **All in favor – 5-0**

6. Motion by Mayor Lattanzi, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve and ratify expenditures for General Fund Warrant Nos. 09012017, 09082017, 09152017, 09222017 and 09292017. **All in favor – 5-0**
Councilman Kurta abstained from voting on any bills for Comcast.
