NEW BUSINESS:



2. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson authorizing the proper officers to sign the Letter of Agreement with the Dollar Energy Fund for the Dollar Energy Hardship Program. **All in favor – 4-0**
3. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Mayor Lattanzi to appoint Russell Behary to a four (4) year term of on the Planning Commission. Term to run through December 31st, 2020. **All in favor – 4-0**
4. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve Change Order # 2 in the amount of \$37,049.58 for A. Liberoni, Inc. under the Milling & Resurfacing Contract No. 2016-03. **All in favor – 4-0**
5. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve Pay Application No. 3 and Final to A. Liberoni, Inc. in the amount of \$ 37,616.98 for work under the Milling and Resurfacing Contract No. 2016-03, with payment for the Capital Projects Fund. **All in favor – 4-0**
