2. Motion Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve the minutes of the July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meeting of City Council.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to ratify the Mayor's Declaration of Emergency Disaster issued on July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in regards to the mulch pile fire in the area of Worthington Avenue, St. Clair Avenue and 7<sup>th</sup> Street. **All in favor – 5-0**

2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$63,634.40 for the 2017 Milling and Resurfacing Contract No. 2017-02 with A. Liberoni, Inc. for work on Ravine Avenue, Mullen Avenue and Maple Avenue from State Route 837 to Railroad Way. **All in favor – 5-0**
3. Motion by Councilwoman Johnson, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich appointing the Duncan Insurance Group as the Agent / Broker for all City insurance programs effective immediately. **All in favor – 5-0**
4. Motion by Councilman Kurta, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to accept the proposal from the Duncan Financial Group and East Coast Risk Management for the implementation of a Workers Compensation Risk Management Program at a monthly cost of \$1,890.00. **All in favor 5-0**
5. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich authorizing the Solicitor to prepare the deeds and necessary documents in order to transfer ownership of lot & blocks 764-C-187 and 764-C-192 from the Clairton Volunteer Fireman Relief Association to the City of Clairton and to file any required documents to have the parcels declared tax exempt for the reason of being a City owned public playground. **All in favor – 5-0**
6. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Mayor Lattanzi approving the proposal from the Surveillance Group for the installation and upgrade of the camera system throughout the City and providing for yearly maintenance at a capital equipment cost of \$11,464.90 and first year maintenance fee of \$1,230 and to include if possible in the system the cameras at Millvue Acres and Carver Hall. **All in favor – 5-0**
7. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve and ratify expenditures for General Fund Warrant Nos. 07072017, 07142017, 07212017 and 07282017. **All in favor – 5-0**
