**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. City Council met in Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss legal and personnel matters.
2. Motion by Mayor Lattanzi, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve the minutes of the May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meeting of City Council. **All in favor – 5-0**

**CITIZEN COMMENTS:**

Barbara McCullough – problems up at Century Townhomes with potholes, high hedges blocking signs and some vacant properties that are open and some people putting out their garbage too soon before pick-up.

Bessie James – House at Reed & Baker, the hedges need cut again.

**NEW BUSINESS:**


1. Motion Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve and adopt Resolution No. 1704 approving that the acquisition and subsequent disposition of numerous parcels of vacant property known as lots & blocks numbers 879-M-290 and 879-M-292 through the Allegheny County Vacant Property Recovery Program would be in accordance with the Comprehensive Plan of the City of Clairton. **All in favor – 5-0**
2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson to approve the contract amendment through the SHACOG Purchasing Alliance with Cargill, Inc. for rock salt purchases for the 2017 – 2018 season. **All in favor – 5-0**
3. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilman Kurta to approve the purchase of a new T550 T4 Bobcat Compact Track Loader through the Pennsylvania Co-Stars Joint Purchasing Program from Bobcat of Pittsburgh in the amount of \$38,810.30 as per quote number HMM-03653, with payment from the Capital Projects Fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
4. Motion by Councilman Kurta, seconded by Councilman Ford authorizing the purchase of three (3) AED (Automated External Defibrillators) devices at a cost of \$1,265 per device from HeartSavers Plus, with payment from the Capital Projects Fund. **All in favor – 5-0**
5. Motion Mayor Lattanzi, seconded by Councilman Ford to approve an amendment to Article No. 7 – Section 4 of the contract between the City of Clairton and Teamsters Local No. 205 representing Clairton Police Department Employees to provide a yearly uniform allowance for part-time patrol officers and Article 22 – Section 7 dealing with police hiring procedures. **All in favor – 5-0**

6. Motion by Mayor Lattanzi, seconded by Councilman Kurta appointing James Cerqua to the Board of the Clairton Municipal Authority, with the term to run through the January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. **All in favor – 5-0**
7. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson authorizing the Steel Rivers Council of Governments to process Payment Application #1 from Mele & Mele & Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$65,813.23 for work completed on Lafayette Drive and 10<sup>th</sup> Street under contract CDBG-42. **All in favor – 5-0**
8. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Lasich allocating up to \$60,000.00 towards the payoff of the Fire Department 2011 HME Rosenbauer Pumper fire truck. **All in favor – 5-0**
9. Motion by Deputy Mayor Lasich to approve and ratify expenditures for General Fund Warrant Nos. 05012017, 05052017, 05122017, 05192017 and 05262017. **All in favor – 5-0** – Councilman Kurta abstained from voting on any Comcast bills
