1. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Councilwoman Lasich approving Ordinance No. 1966 establishing the Real Estate Tax Rate for the Fiscal Year 2022 and imposing discounts, penalties and interest thereon. **All in favor – 5-0**
2. Motion by Deputy Mayor Kurta, seconded by Councilwoman Lasich approving Ordinance No.1967 adopting a budget for the Fiscal Year beginning January 1st, 2022 and ending December 31st, 2022, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Clairton. **All in favor – 5-0**

3. Motion by Councilwoman Lasich, seconded by Deputy Mayor Kurta approving Ordinance No. 1968 providing for salaries and wages of employees and officials of the City of Clairton for the period beginning January 1st, 2022 and thereafter. **All in favor -5-0**

4. Motion by Councilwoman Lasich, seconded by Councilwoman Johnson-Clemmons approving Ordinance No. 1969 fixing the Legislative and workshop meetings schedule of the City of Clairton Council for the year 2022. **All in favor – 5-0**

5. Motion by Councilman Ford, seconded by Deputy Mayor Kurta to direct Keystone Collections to produce a Tax Certification as to 252 State Street, which reflects the City of Clairton shall accept five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) from the closing, and exonerate all back real estate taxes accordingly, contingent upon the Clairton City School District and Allegheny County similarly issuing tax certifications in amounts not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) each. **Motion Passed 4-1**


